Full-Time Police Officer

The Town of Skowhegan is seeking qualified applicants for the position of a full-time police officer. General duties include motor vehicle patrol, traffic control, and criminal and traffic investigations. Qualified applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalent, be 21 years of age, or 20 years of age with an Associates Degree or 60 credit hours of post secondary education in Criminal Justice or related field and a valid driver's license. Successful candidates will be subject to a background investigation, polygraph, and psychological exam.

MCJA Alert Test and Pre-Service Phase I and II certification required. Must pass physical agility test within 6 months of the date of hire. Preference for applicants who are certified Maine Criminal Justice Academy graduates.

The Skowhegan Police Department has a compliment of 16 Full Time Officers and is striving to be a pro active department with opportunities for specialized training and career advancement. Officers work a favorable schedule with 12 hour shifts and a 42 hour pay week.

Applicants with experience can be laterally entered into our pay scale at up to 5 years experience at the town's discretion. Selected applicants who have graduated from the Maine Criminal Justice Academy as tuition students are eligible for a competitive signing bonus.
